- **1.** <u>Student Eligibility:</u> Senior undergraduate students from (preferably 5th to 7th semester) engineering streams, enrolled fulltime in TEQIP-III institutions are eligible to apply to the program.
- 2. Students will go to Canada during the period of May to June in 2018 and will stay back for next 12 weeks.
- 3. To apply, students must provide:
 - Transcripts for all completed undergraduate coursework, if this is not available in English, student must submit a translated and notarized copy before the application deadline.
 - CV that details their research experience
 - At least one reference letter from an academic research professor or supervisor
 - Expression of research interest
- 4. The program is competitive and in addition to the above, students are evaluated on a combination of factors including their academic records and skills appropriate to the projects. Students must:
 - Have a minimum grade point average of 9.0 to apply to the program
 - Completed the age of 18
 - Demonstrate oral and written fluency in English or French, depending on the language of preference as noted by the host professor
 - Select at least three(3) and no more than seven (7) projects from at least (3) of Canada's provinces and/or territories and
 - Student must possess a passport that is valid at least until January 2020.
 - Must complete application by September 19, 2018 at 1.00 PM pacific daylight time.
