
**Criteria for PG Silver Medals**

It has been noticed that there is some confusion on the number of programs (specializations) of the notified winners list for the PG Silver Medals, to be awarded during XVII convocation. In this regard, it may be noted that due to various reasons, award of the PG medals was discontinued. However, the PG silver medals were re-introduced since XV convocation. As decided by the Institute, the following prescribed criteria are presently applicable for a student to be eligible for the award of silver medal in a given Program (Specialization):

- He/she has to be a regular student and pass all the prescribed subjects and cleared all other requirements, if any, obtaining an overall CPI not lower than 9.5.
- He/ she scores at least 9 CPI, excluding project/thesis works.
- He/she has not failed in any subject at any stage during his/her academic career in that program.
- No disciplinary action has been taken against him/her for any offence violating code of conduct at any stage during his/her academic career in that program

The topper who fulfills these criteria are awarded the silver medal. Accordingly, the toppers of five PG specializations only have been found to be the winners this time (XVII convocation).

The same criteria were used while selecting the winners for the last convocation as well.
