At the outset, the Director & Chairman Senate welcomed all the Senate members and the special invitees. The Senate then initiated the discussion on the agenda items and the following resolutions were adopted.

S-88/24/01: To consider confirmation of minutes of the 85th, 86th (Emergent) & 87th (Emergent) meetings of the Senate

The draft minutes of the 85th & 87th (Emergent) meetings of the Senate was circulated to all the members of the Senate (**Annexure-I**) and (**Annexure-III**) respectively. The Senate may confirm the minutes.

Further, the minutes of the 86th (Emergent) meeting was confirmed on the table (**Annexure-II**). The Senate may note the same.

Decision:

The Senate confirmed the minutes of the 85th & 87th (Emergent) meetings of the Senate and also noted the confirmed minutes of the 86th (Emergent) meeting of the Senate.

S-88/24/02: To consider action taken on the decision adopted in the 85th, 86th (Emergent) & 87th (Emergent) meetings of the Senate

The Senate may note the action taken report on the decision adopted in the 85th, 86th (Emergent) & 87th (Emergent) meetings of the Senate at (**Annexure-I**), (**Annexure-II**) and (**Annexure-III**) respectively.

S-88/24/03: To consider and recommend awarding degrees to all the graduating students (B.Tech., M.Tech., M.Sc., MBA) who have qualified for the same.

The list of students in various programs who have passed in the end semester examination of final semester in 2024 and have qualified for the award of the degree are as follows:

- (a) 823 B.Tech. students (**Annexure IV**)
(CE=131, ME=128, EE=134, ECE=175, CSE=176, EIE=79)
- (b) 158 M.Tech. students (**Annexure V**)
(CE= 64, ME= 29, EE= 17, ECE= 25, CSE= 22, EIE= 1)
- (c) 59 M.Sc. students (**Annexure VI**)
(Chemistry= 20, Mathematics= 21, Physics= 18)
- (d) 50 MBA students (**Annexure VII**)
- (e) Statistics of result of three years (**Annexure VIII**)

Further, one UG student viz. Chukka Venkata Ramana bearing Registration No. 2014099 having I Grade in 8th sem, passed the exam in July 2024 and has qualified for the award of the degree (**Annexure IX**).

It may be noted that Provisional Certificates have been issued to these students with the approval of the competent authority.

S-88/24/04: To consider and recommend the list of graduating students of UG 2020-24 batch & PG 2022-24 batch who have qualified for the Degree in Summer Semester Examination & Supplementary Examination

29 students of UG 2020-24 batch have completed all the requirements and qualified for the B.Tech. degree in the Summer Semester Examination (01) and Supplementary Examination (28) held in July-Aug 2024. List of these students is placed at **Annexure X**.

01 student of PG 2022-24 batch has completed all the requirements and qualified for the MBA degree in the Supplementary Examination held in July-Aug 2024. **Annexure XI.**

It may be noted that Provisional Certificates have been issued to these students with the approval of the competent authority.

S-88/24/05: To consider & recommend the names of few more students who qualify for the B.Tech degree after the last 21st Convocation & before the 22nd Convocation 2024

07 students completed the requirements and qualified for the B.Tech. Degree after the last Convocation held on 2nd Nov. 2023 and before the ensuing Convocation 2024. List of the students who have qualified for the B.Tech degree is given in **Annexure- XII.**

The Senate may consider the list of students and recommend to the Board of Governors for approval.

Decision:

*The Senate considered the list of the graduating students who have qualified for the award of the B.Tech. degree after the last Convocation held in Nov. 2023 and before the ensuing Convocation 2024 and recommended the same to the Board of Governors for approval. S-88/24/06: To consider and recommend awarding various medals at the 22nd Convocation to the graduating students (B.Tech., M.Tech., M.Sc. and MBA) who have been found eligible for the same

A committee comprising of all HoD's & Mr. B. Nath, Assoc. Dean (Acad) as convenor was constituted to finalise the name of the medal winners in various disciplines of UG & PG Programme.

The students who have been recommended by the committee for the award of the Institute Gold / Silver Medals in the respective programme/specialisation is given in **Annexure-XIII**.

The Senate may consider the names of the medal winners for 2024 and recommend the same to the BoG for approval.

Decision:

The Senate considered the names of the medal winners for the UG & PG programme and recommended the same to the Board of Governors for approval.

S-88/24/07: **To consider and recommend the winner of the (a) Best Doctoral Award (b) Best All Round Graduate Award (c) Kalikrishna-Mrinalini Deb Krori Award and (d) Saswata Purkayastha Memorial Award.**

(a) The Institute is offering a Best Doctoral Award (gold plated medal). The award is presented to the one who is found to be the best performer in his/her Ph.D work, among the Ph.D Degree recipients in a given Convocation.

(b) The Institute is offering a Best All Round Graduate Award (gold plated medal). The award is presented to the one who is found to be the best all round performer among the B.Tech. Degree recipients in a given Convocation.

(c) The Kalikrishna-Mrinalini Deb Krori Award (gold plated medal) is awarded to the best engineering graduate and is sponsored by Prof. K.D Krori, former Principle, Cotton College in memory of his parents. The award is presented to the best degree recipient among the B.Tech. Degree recipients in a given convocation.

(d) The Saswata Purkayastha Memorial Award (gold plated medal) is awarded to the best Gymkhana member. This award is sponsored by the parents of Late Saswata Purkayastha who was a General Secretary of the students' Gymkhana and died in a tragic road accident. The award is limited amongst outgoing students who were members of the Students' Gymkhana.

The performance is judged on the basis of few defined criteria for a given award. Based on the defined criteria, the recommendation of the committee for the aforesaid awards are as mentioned below.

(a) BEST DOCTORAL AWARD – SOUMYA RANJAN MISHRA (21-3-07-028), DEPT. OF CHEMISTRY

(b) BEST ALL ROUND GRADUATE AWARD – ANANYA KALITA (2016008), ME DEPTT.

(c) KALIKRISHNA-MRINALINI DEB KRORI AWARD – MRIGANGA JYOTI CHUTIA (2016006), ME DEPTT.

(d) SASWATA PURKAYASTHA MEMORIAL AWARD – MIRAJ DEKA (2013007), EE DEPTT.

The Senate may consider the same and recommend the awardees to the BoG for approval.

Decision: *The Senate considered the names of the awardees and recommended the same to the Board of Governors for approval.*

S-88/24/08: To consider and recommend Shubhankar Pandit Memorial Award to the UG Branch Topper of EE Deptt.

Shubhankar Pandit Memorial Award was introduced in the year 2022 in the memory of Late Shubhankar Pandit. The award is conferred to the UG Branch Topper of EE Deptt. in the form of gold-plated medal.

In the ensuing Convocation 2024, the Institute is going to confer the Shubhankar Pandit Memorial Award to Miraj Deka (2013007), the UG Branch Topper of EE Deptt. with a CGPA of 9.79.

The Senate may consider the same and recommend the name of the awardee to the BoG for approval.

Decision:

The Senate considered the name of the awardee and recommended the same to the Board of Governors for approval.

S-88/24/09: To consider and recommend awarding degrees to the students who qualified for PhD Degree for the year 2024

The list of students who have completed all requirements and qualified for the award of PhD degree in the 22nd Convocation will be placed on the table.

The Senate may consider the list of students who have qualified for the PhD degree and recommend the same to the BoG for approval.

Decision:

The Senate considered the list of the students who have qualified for the award of the PhD Degree and recommended the same to the Board of Governors for approval. The list of students (119 nos.) is enclosed at Annexure-E.

S-88/24/10: To ratify the action taken by the Chairman Senate regarding reduction of grade

The following students bearing registration number 2016117, 2013028, 2015083, 2012066 were rusticated for one semester (7th semester) as per O O No. NITS/RO/Order/23/15946-16000. Later they were allowed to appear summer semester and supplementary examination for the 7th semester subjects with the approval of competent authority. However, it was decided to reduce the result by one grade as these students have not attended classes in regular semester.

In the meeting held on 10th Sept 2024 in the Director's Office, in presence of Director Sir, All HoDs, Dean SW and Dean Academic, it has been decided to keep the ceiling for the lowest grade as DD. It means for higher grades one grade deduction is imposed except DD grade. But for the cases where a student got DD grade i.e the lowest grade, the grade cannot be reduced to F Grade. Thus, a student getting DD grade was not reduced to F grade.

The said decision was approved by the Chairman Senate.

The Senate is requested to ratify the action taken by the Chairman Senate.

Decision:

The Senate ratified the action taken by the Chairman Senate.



(A) To consider the result of one M.Tech. student of EE Dept. who has qualified for the award of the degree

One student of EE Dept. Manash Pratim Chakravarty bearing registration number 2223116 initially secured CGPA 5.9. The department has reviewed the result and noted that in the 3rd semester one component of the supervisor mark was overlooked while compilation. After considering the correct marks it was noted that his grade was improved from CC to BC in the 3rd semester thus his final CGPA also changed from 5.9 to 6.02. The said student has now qualified for the award of the M.Tech. degree.

The Senate may consider this and recommend the same to the Board of Governors for approval.

Decision:

The Senate opined that the agenda item be dropped and the decision taken in this regard be reflected in the minutes of the agenda item no. S-88/24/03.

(B) To ratify the approval of Chairman, Senate in respect of extension of Ph.D. program

As per the clause 6.12 of the Ph.D. regulations, “the maximum duration of the program, including all granted leaves, is 06 years for the date of admission for full-time students and 07 years for part-time students. Unless the Senate otherwise allows, the registration of a student shall stand cancelled automatically after the expiry of stipulated duration”. The following students could not complete their studies within the stipulated periods due to various reasons, including reason related to medical issues and applied for extension to complete their works. Considering their request and on the basis of recommendations of the respective DC, the Chairman, Senate allowed extensions as listed below.
