At the outset, the Director & Chairman Senate welcomed all the Senate members and special invitees. The Senate then initiated the discussion on the agenda items and the following resolutions were adopted.



S-91/25/01 **To consider the new UG Course Structure framed as per the NEP 2020 guidelines**

A committee has been constituted for the implementation of the NEP at NIT Silchar vide order no. NITS/Estt/Committee/14/27128-35 dated 10.12.2024. The said committee has proposed the UG Course Structure (Semester-I to Semester-VIII) as per the NEP guidelines to be made effective from the Academic Year 2025-26.

The report submitted by the committee in this regard is placed at **Annexure-I**.

The Senate is requested to deliberate on the matter & take a suitable decision accordingly.

Decision:

At the outset the Senate appreciated the committee for framing the UG course structure as per the NEP guidelines. After detailed deliberations, the Senate suggested some modifications in the course structure. The modifications suggested are incorporated in the Course Structure and is annexed herewith. The Senate also resolved that the minimum credit requirement for completing the UG course will be 170 credits and the maximum duration for completing the course will be 08 years. Further, the EAA courses will be offered during 1st to 4th semester. The Senate also opined to place the matter in the next Senate meeting for finalisation of the new course structure.

S-91/25/02 **To consider modification in the course structure of Transportation Engg.**

The Department of Civil Engg. vide its letter dated 03.04.2025 have submitted the modified course structure for the M.Tech. specialisation in Transportation Engineering. The report submitted by the Dept. is placed at **Annexure-II**.

The Senate is requested to deliberate on the matter & take a suitable decision accordingly.

Decision:

The Senate approved the modified course structure of Transportation Engineering. However, the Senate advised the HoD, CE Dept. to review the course outcome.
