At the onset, the Director & Chairman Senate welcomed all the Senate members and special invitees. To mark respect & pay homage to the departed soul of three 1<sup>st</sup> year UG students, the Senate observed one minute silence.

The Director & Chairman Senate informed that the Chairperson, BoG of NIT Silchar has not been nominated yet. He further apprised that in a meeting held with the Jt. Secretary, Ministry of Education, GoI, the Director & Chairman Senate has been authorised to approve the result and the list of degree recipients including the medal winners & awardees to be conferred in the ensuing 23<sup>rd</sup> Convocation 2025 and later ratify the decision in the meeting of the BoG. From the ensuing Convocation 2025 onwards, the Degree Certificates, Medal/Award Winner Certificates shall be signed by the Registrar and Director & Chairman Senate of the Institute and may be reviewed in the future, if need be.

The Senate then initiated the discussion on the agenda items and the following resolutions were adopted.

**S- To consider confirmation of minutes of the 92<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Senate**

*Further, it was brought to the notice of the Senate that based on the request received from the students/parents of the final year UG 2021-25 Batch, who were involved in the adoption of unfair means in the examination, the Dean (Academic) submitted a note vide dated 05.06.2025 to the Director to revisit the matter of punishment imposed, considering the issue of their job and higher studies. Based on the discussion in a meeting of all Deans and HoDs, the Chairman, Senate permitted these final year students to sit in the supplementary examination with a condition that their results be declared in December 2025. The copy of the approval of the competent authority in this regard was exhibited to the Senate".*

(a) The Institute is offering a Best Doctoral Award (gold plated medal). The award is presented to the one who is found to be the best performer in his/her Ph.D work, among the Ph.D Degree recipients in a given Convocation.

(b) The Institute is offering a Best All Round Graduate Award (gold plated medal). The award is presented to the one who is found to be the best all round performer among the B.Tech. Degree recipients in a given Convocation.

(c) The Kalikrishna-Mrinalini Deb Krori Award (gold plated medal) is awarded to the best engineering graduate and is sponsored by Prof. K.D Krori, former Principle, Cotton College in memory of his parents. The award is presented to the best degree recipient among the B.Tech. Degree recipients in a given convocation.

(d) The Saswata Purkayastha Memorial Award (gold plated medal) is awarded to the best Gymkhana member. This award is sponsored by the parents of Late Saswata Purkayastha who was a General Secretary of the students' Gymkhana and died in a tragic road accident. The award is limited amongst outgoing students who were members of the Students' Gymkhana.
